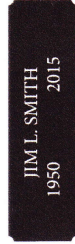


Guidelines for the purchase of a bronze plaque on the new Commemorative Monument:

1. Plaques may only be purchased by persons with a demonstrated connection to Waterton Park.
2. Plaques may be purchased to commemorate the life of a deceased person and not for any other reason (no pets, no events, no living person).
3. A space may be reserved for a living person, but will not be installed until the person has passed away. Payment must be made before a space can be reserved.
4. Location of the plaques on the monument may be chosen by individuals from remaining available spaces. Please visit the WPCA office to choose the location of your plaque.
5. Style of names and dates will be uniform. Size of lettering may vary depending on length of name.
6. All plaques will be ordered and affixed by the monument committee.
7. All requests subject to review by the WPCA Monument Committee.

Purchase of Plaque



Plaque for a deceased person will be 2 x 7 in size. The size of the double plaque is 4 x 7". Since space will be limited, only the person's name, birth year and death year will be displayed. Please note that the larger plaque must be used for two names and not just one name. Please include a cheque made out to the Waterton Park Community Association.

Single name plaque: \$450*
 Double name plaque: \$800*

* These prices include the bronze casting and placing of the plaque on the monument. Payment by cash, cheque, or credit card.

Please print the name, birth date and death date in large, legible letters. Please print them EXACTLY as you wish them to appear on the plaque. The letters will be centred when cast.

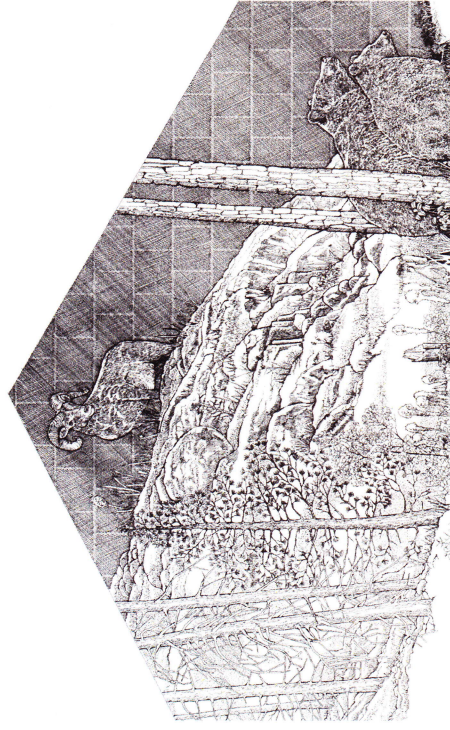

He has received many awards for his work, most lately the Alberta Order of Excellence in 2013.
